PART 1 – CAPSTONE CAFÉ

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- * Be prepared to speak to any of the following reflective questions:
 - Summarize your work and / or volunteer experience through the past 4 years.
 - Describe experiences during the past three years that you are most proud of.
 - Describe your strengths. In what areas would you like to grow further?
 - Describe any contributions you may have made to your school and/or community.
 - What is your plan for next year? Post-Secondary / Employment / Travel
 - How are you going to finance your plans?
 - What are your long-term goals for the future?
 - Describe how your personality, strengths, and past achievements match your future plans.

PART 2 - CAPSTONE PRESENTATIONS

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Speak about an artifact/piece(s) of evidence related to your capstone that is meaningful to you and worthy of inclusion in your final presentation. Explain why this piece of evidence deserves to be part of your presentation. Examples of artifacts/evidence could include: a film/video, a document, a slide show, a performance, a portfolio, a short story, or something constructed.

Please make sure to address the following reflective questions:

- Why did you select this topic?
- How is your artifact meaningful to you and why are you including it?
- How does this project connect with you personally or your career plans?
- What have you learned or accomplished through this process?
- What were some challenges that you faced?
