INSTRUCTIONS:

IMPORTANT: Students must successfully complete at least one **Indigenous Focused** course for graduation. BC First Peoples 12, Contemporary Indigenous Studies 12, English First Peoples Literary Studies and New Media 11, and English First Peoples 12 all meet this requirement. English First Peoples 12 can be taken in place of English Studies 12 to meet the grade 12 language arts requirement. Additionally, either BC First Peoples 12 or Contemporary Indigenous Studies 12 can be taken to meet the Social Studies 11 or 12 graduation requirement.

Career Education 12 is a required course and will be offered in class.

If you plan to study at the post secondary level, we strongly recommend that you check the entrance requirements for the schools and programs that interest you and choose your courses accordingly. Most universities will require that you have 3-4 academic courses in addition to English Studies 12 or English First Peoples 12. Some universities will also require that you have a 2nd language up to the grade 11 level. Psychology 12 and Renaissance Studies 12 do not count as an academic grade 12 course in the eyes of post-secondary schools.

To complete your requests, please choose courses from the grade 11&12 Course Option Sheet and list them **in order of preference** in the **COURSE SELECTION** box to the right. Then list three back up choices.

If you would like to take a course offered through SHIFT, please write (SHIFT) next to course name. The courses offered through SHIFT are listed on the back of this form (Gr.11 & 12 Course Option Sheet).

Don't forget to add any **REQUIRED** grade 10 or 11 courses (English, Science, Math, Social Studies, PE, Career Ed.), that you have not yet completed. If you're not sure, ask a counsellor.

Leadership, Choir, Jazz Band, and VEX Robotics are outside the timetable courses and won't count toward your 8 total. Please sign up by ticking the box.

Do not add a Support Block as one of your choices. Please arrange to meet with a counsellor to discuss options once you have received your timetable in August.
