## PROCEDURE 203 Property Control

- 1. No person shall drive any motorized or human powered vehicle on or over any land (including roadways) owned or administered by the School District #64 Board of Education, (hereinafter referred to as "the board") except:
  - a. employees of the board
  - b. students
  - c. parents/guardians
  - d. other persons either having business with the district, or a district school, or having obtained prior permission in writing from the board.
- 2. The board may erect devices to regulate, prohibit, control and direct vehicular and pedestrian traffic on land owned or administered by the board.
- 3. No person shall
  - a. exceed the speed limits posted on district property
  - b. park or otherwise leave unattended, upon land or roadways owned or administered by the board, except in areas designated for parking, unless permission to do otherwise is given by the board in writing
  - c. park a vehicle and leave its engine running in areas posted as no idle zones, or park a vehicle and leave its engine running for more than three minutes otherwise.
  - d. trespass, cross over or loiter upon any land owned or administered by the board between the hours of 1/2 hour after sunset and 1/2 hour before sunrise without the written permission of the board or an agent of the board.
  - e. take or allow to be taken any domestic or range animal onto land owned or administered by the board without the written permission of the board.

- 4. When directed by an authorised district employee to leave property administered by the school district, a person or persons shall do so immediately, consistent with provisions in the *School Act* and Policy 205.
- 5. Individuals or groups using properties, facilities or equipment controlled by the board
  - a. may be asked or directed to leave consistent with provisions in Policy 205
  - b. may be subject to video monitoring (as per Policy 3650)
  - c. shall do so consistent with provisions in Policy 6850.
