POLICY 3055 Weapons and Dangerous Objects

"Inspire learners, Integrate sustainability, Involve community"

Section: Health and Safety Dates of Revisions: Date of Adoption and Resolution Number: June 13, 2018 -76/18

Policy:

- 1. School principals will make staff, students (and parents) aware that:
 - a. weapons of any kind are prohibited on school premises;
 - b. students found with knives, firearms including pellet guns, replicas of guns or other dangerous objects on their person or in their possession, (for example: in purses, backpacks, lockers, or in vehicles on school property) are in violation of their school Code of Conduct and, therefore, subject to disciplinary action;
 - c. any object used in a reckless or dangerous manner and with intent to threaten or injure will be considered a weapon
- 2. As well, staff, students and parents should be advised that:
 - a. carrying a concealed weapon is contrary to the Criminal Code of Canada.
 - b. that anyone convicted of carrying a concealed weapon is liable to imprisonment. Students should be encouraged to understand and accept that it is their social responsibility and civic duty to report any violation of this policy.
