POLICY 3056 Unwelcome Visitors/Intruders

"Inspire learners, Integrate sustainability, Involve community"

Section: Health and Safety Dates of Revisions: Date of Adoption and Resolution Number: June 13, 2018 -76/18

## **Rationale:**

The School District No. 64 Board of Education's Policy 205 authorizes school administrators and their designates to make orders to prevent and address any disturbance, disruption or interruption of a school, pursuant to section 177 of the School Act.

While the board believes that "unwelcome visitors" are likely to leave the school property without incident, when asked or directed to do so, it nonetheless develops further policy, consistent with its Policy 205, to address situations in which an "unwelcome visitor" engages in aggressive or violent behaviour, and compromises the safety and well-being of students, employees, and visitors to the school.

## **Policy:**

In circumstances where the behaviour or presence of individuals in a district school or workplace is detrimental or hazardous to the welfare of the students and/or employees and/or harmful to district property or grounds (see Policy 203), the board

- 1. directs the Superintendent of Schools, directors or their equivalents, Principals/Vice Principals and their designates to maintain order using the authority provided for Section 177 of the School Act, and in a manner consistent with Policy 205.
- 2. expects that Principals will, in consultation with school staffs, develop locallyappropriate procedures to protect students, staff and visitors to the school, in situations in which their safety and well-being is threatened by "unwelcome visitors"/intruders
