- 1. Where a school is being considered for closure, the following procedure will be followed:
 - a. The Board of Education will bring forward at a regular public meeting of the board any consideration for closure of a school.
 - b. Prior to any final decision on school closure the board will enter into a publicized 60-day consultation process with district and school staff, local government, community groups and the general public.
 - c. Staff Consultation
 - i. Notice to representatives of staff at the school to be closed and other schools to be impacted.
 - ii. Meeting with the board representatives and staff of school to be closed.
 - iii. Meeting with board representatives and staff of schools to be impacted.
 - iv. Opportunity for written input.

d. Public Consultation

- i. Notice to District Parents' Advisory Council, the Parent Advisory Council and parents of the school considered for closure, and other schools to be impacted.
- ii. Notice in media to communities affected by the school closure and the consequential changes to other schools.
- iii. At least one (1) public meeting held at the school being considered for closure.
- iv. Opportunity for written response.
- 2. At a subsequent board meeting, the Board of Education will make its final decision on the proposed school closure after taking into fair consideration the input received through the consultation process.
- **3.** Following a board decision to permanently close a school, the Secretary Treasurer will promptly notify the Minister of Education, including the school name, facility number, address and date of closure.
