- Liaises and works with school and district staff and job related contacts
- Researches, purchases and inventories supplies and equipment
- Maintains tools and equipment in a safe manner
- Attends building alarms and other site emergencies after hours as required
- Operates district vehicles and equipment
- Supervises assistant(s) as required
- Performs general maintenance duties
- Performs other assigned duties within the area of knowledge and skill required by the job description
