Country Grocer Save-A-Tape Community Program:

Thank you so much to everyone over the years, and up until recently also, who donated their country grocer receipts to Fernwood Elementary School teacher classrooms, learning services and the Fernwood PAC. The paper receipt process has now stopped and is now a convenient 'point of sale' process at the store. In line with Country Grocer's philosophy of sharing with the community, we have opted to keep it simple and have two options to choose from at the receipt scanning kiosk. There will be box number 114 to choose for Fernwood Elementary School which will be shared equally between all classrooms and a second box for Fernwood Elementary PAC. Annually approximately \$3000+ comes to our school from the Country Grocer Save-A-Tape program: this subsidizes the cost of field

trips, purchases items for the classrooms and for learning services, and helps with special event costs. Thanks for your continued support and thank you to Country Grocer
