September Information Packages

Next week we will be sending home information packages for parents that will include a consent form (photo release, consent for local walking trips, etc.), emergency release form and the "student verification of information" form. Parents need to confirm that the information on the verification form is accurate. If the information is all current, please sign and return it to the school; if it contains inaccurate information, please write the correct info and then sign and return the form. When adding names to the emergency release forms, please write the names of anyone who may pick your child up, including parents of your child's friends who may pick up for playdates. You can add a separate page with the contact person's name and phone number if there is not enough room on the form. **District policy states that we are not permitted to release students to anyone other than the people listed on the emergency contact sheet.** You are welcome to add names to the emergency release contacts throughout the year by sending us an email directing us to add the name and phone number of the person you would like to add.

Parent Volunteer Criminal Record Check

If you would like to be a parent volunteer in the school or on field trips, please make sure your criminal record check is on file and valid. Teachers are starting to organize field trips, so it is important that we have parent volunteers approved. Once the criminal record check is completed, it is valid for 5 years. Supervision Before and After School

We can provide supervision from 7:50 – 8:20 am and 3:10 – 3:25 pm. Please do not drop your child off before 7:50 am unless you are able to stay with them, and please be sure to pick them up before 3:25 pm. Students who arrive early or stay late will be brought into the office for supervision. Please note that in the morning, students must stay on the front side of the school until the bell rings at 8:20 am because that is where we have supervision.
